Upon recent verification of the original data underlying our previous work, the authors discovered that the images of LR@CeSACs tissue section used to characterize IL-6 levels in Figs. 5F and 8H were inappropriately duplicated and mistakenly overlapped with an image presented in the image of LR@CeSACs tissue section used to characterize TNF- α levels in Fig. 8H. This error resulted from a mishandling of image files by a member of the research team. The authors wish to clarify that this duplication

was unintentional and, crucially, does not impact the main findings or conclusions of the study. The authors deeply regret this oversight and have already taken corrective action by preparing a verified, accurate image file for the necessary revisions to Figs. 5F and 8H. 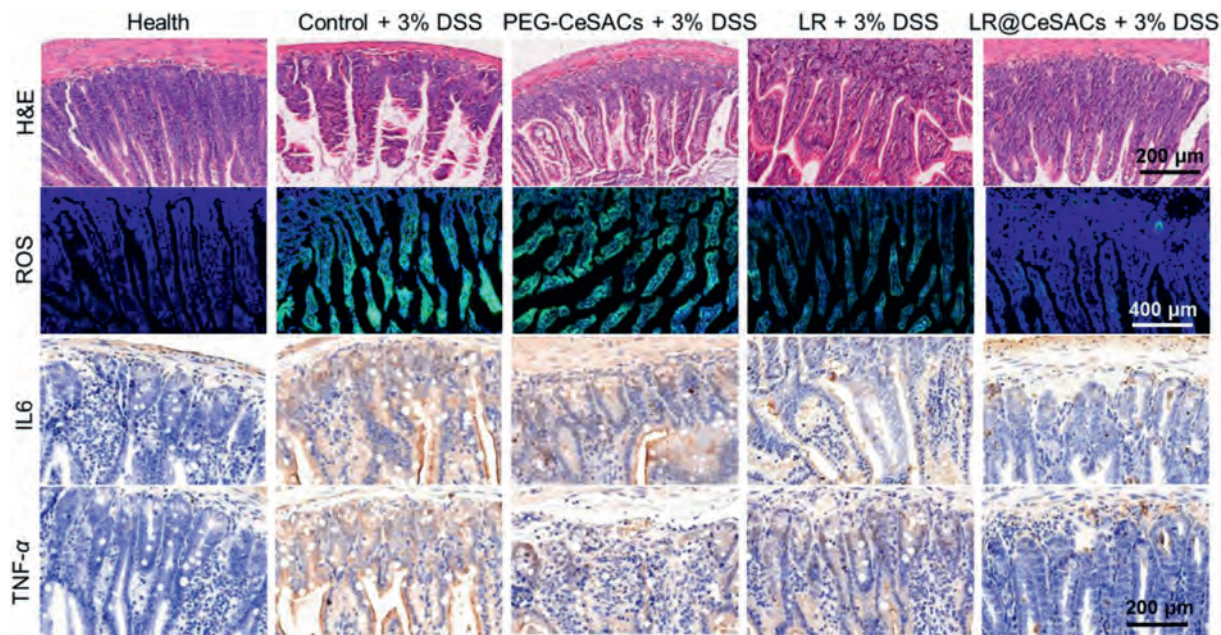
